

**Camp Turk**  
**Registration Day Procedures**  
**For boy campers arriving July 7<sup>th</sup> & July 14<sup>th</sup>**  
**For girl campers arriving July 28<sup>th</sup> & August 4<sup>th</sup>**

Registration is open as follows:

**Boy's Camp**

Boy's Arrival (week 2 & 3)                      **Sunday**, July 7<sup>th</sup> & July 14<sup>th</sup>                      2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

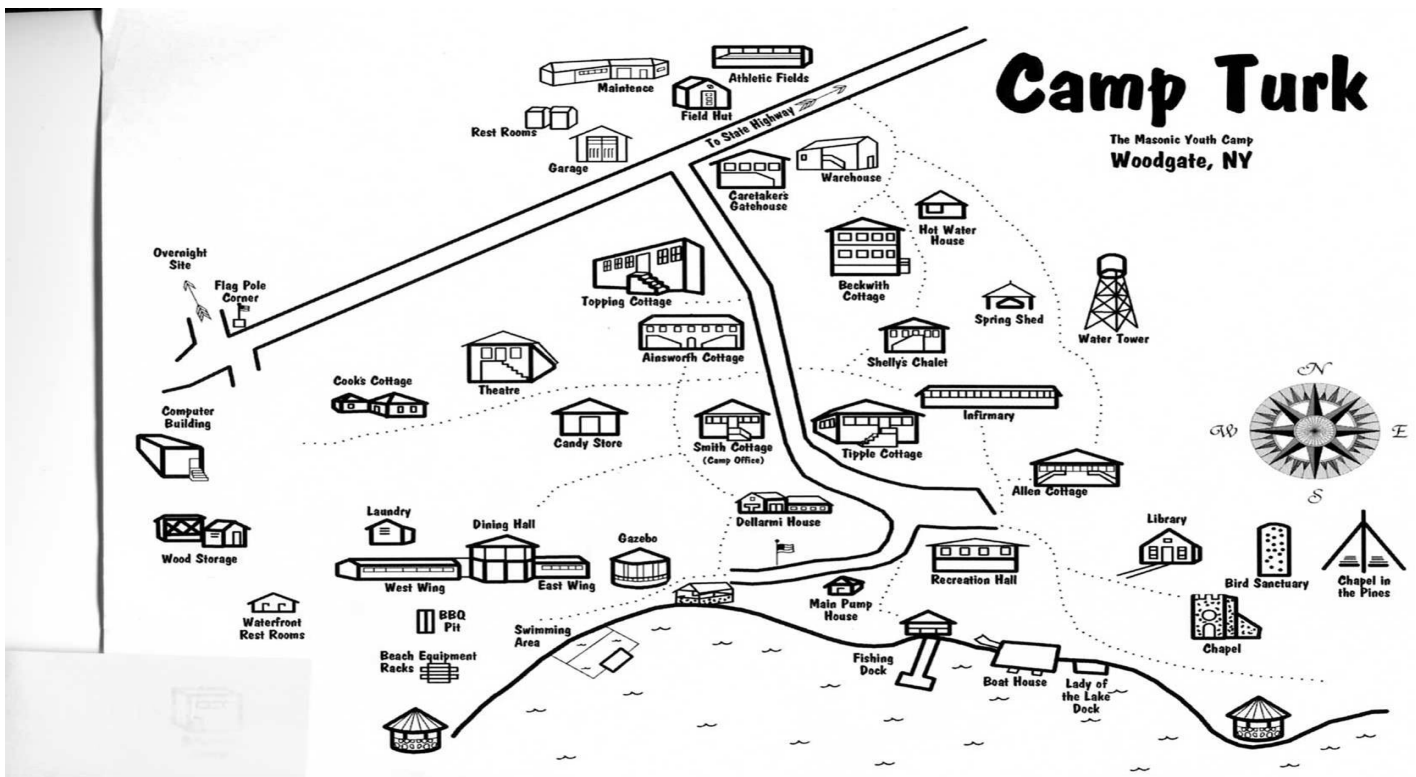
**Girl's Camp**

Girl's Arrival (week 2 & 3)                      **Sunday**, July 28<sup>th</sup> & August 4<sup>th</sup>                      2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

**If you are arriving by train, campers should plan on arriving in Utica around 12:00 NOON. Please let us know in advance due to limited seating in our vans and to make sure a staff member is at the train station to meet your child. There is a \$25.00 fee to pick up your child at the train station and a \$25.00 fee to take them back to the train at the end of camp.**

**AN ADULT MUST BE PRESENT TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD. YOU CANNOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF AND LEAVE! Please make sure you are ON TIME! The gate will open promptly at 2:00 p.m.**

1. Once you arrive you will remain outside the gate until it opens at 2 p.m.
2. At 2 p.m. a Camp Turk counselor will meet you at the parking area. You will obtain a registration card indicating what cabin your child is assigned to. Please make sure you pick up this card, this is how we keep track of what campers have arrived and if additional information is needed from the parent/guardian.
3. If you have heavy luggage a staff member will give you a one tag per piece to place on your luggage. Leave luggage behind your vehicle and we will transport it to the correct cabin.
4. Move your child into their cabin, set up their bed & get them settled in. Campers should change into their swim suits and bring a towel to the Rec. Hall (if they want to put shorts & a shirt on over their swim suit to finish the registration that is fine.
5. Go to the Candy Store to deposit spending money or to make purchases.
6. Go to the Camp Infirmary. This is MANDATORY for all campers.
  - a. You must bring a copy of your child's medical information with you in the event it got lost in the mail. We cannot and will not accept any child without all required medical information. **CAMPERS ARRIVING WITHOUT COMPLETED MEDICAL PAPERWORK WILL BE SENT HOME AND NO REFUND ISSUED!!!**
  - b. Report any special medical problems, sickness or any concerns to the camp nurse.
  - c. The nurse must keep **ALL** medications, including all over the counter medicines such as allergy medication, Tylenol, etc. and prescription medications.
  - d. **If your child has any food allergies, you must report to the dining hall to see the food service manager in addition to seeing the nurse.**
7. Go to the Recreation Hall (**campers will remain in the Recreation Hall once the following is completed.**)
  - a. Photo Identification – All campers must have their photo taken for identification in case of an emergency.
  - b. Memory pack sales. This is a great way to preserve your child's memories at camp. This will be available for pick up on the last day of camp (if you are a one or two week camper or have to leave early this will be mailed to you). This **MUST** be ordered on registration day. **The cost is \$30.00 and includes a cabin photo, staff photo and DVD (photos and video clips) of the camp season. CASH only.**
  - c. Cell phones – **ALL** cell phones must be signed in at the Recreation Hall. Parents should bring cell phones in a zip lock baggie with the camper's name on the baggie, phone & charger. **NO** campers are allowed to keep their phones for any reason!

**NOTES:**

- Pick up is on **SATURDAY** at 10 a.m. (gates will remain closed until 10 a.m.) Please remember to pick up medications in the infirmary if your child has any.
- Remember that all adults picking up campers are required to be listed on your child's application and must be at least 18 years of age. They are also required to have photo identification.
